KEYS TO WINNING

- ▶ Communicate consistently with everyone involved in the process of creating the elementary Kids' City Celebration regarding deadlines and product development.
- ▶ Provide constructive feedback to everyone involved in the process of creating the elementary Kids' City Celebration product.
- ▶ Make sure all curriculum materials are uploaded to the CCC server and NewThing GroupHub at least 4 weeks out (exceptions: DVDs & PPTs).
- ▶ Create a system for assembling Production Packets to ensure every CCC Campus receives needed supplies.
- ▶ Test DVDs and CDs to make sure they are in working condition.
- ▶ Read and research the latest findings in kid culture and child development.
- ▶ Continually trying new and better ideas for the Kids' City Celebration product.
- ▶ Solicit input and feedback from kids and Kids' City leaders on the product.
