



KIDS' CITY WORSHIP LEADER

A Kids' City Producer owns KC Celebration by communicating with artists, running the cue-to-cue rehearsal, and providing feedback to all artists involved in the service.

TIME COMMITMENT

- ▶ Worship leaders serve one weekend a month for multiple KC Celebration Services.
- ▶ Arrive at the time designated by the Arts Coordinator or Producer prepared for the cue-to-cue rehearsal.
- ▶ Preparation time during the week.
- ▶ Participate in Kids' City University.

QUALIFICATIONS

- ▶ Worship Leaders are moving towards maturity in the 3C's: Celebrate, Connect, Contribute.
- ▶ Worship Leaders are committed to being a positive role model. This responsibility applies to speech, actions, and dress.
- ▶ Worship Leaders are gifted in music and communication.
- ▶ Worship Leaders audition and are interviewed by the Kids City Arts Coordinator or Producer.

WHAT DOES A WIN LOOK LIKE?

- ▶ Kids are engaged in the worship songs.
- ▶ The Worship Leader is prepared and knows the words and motions of each song.
- ▶ The Worship Leader articulates the transitions clearly and concisely.
- ▶ Kids know the Worship Leader by name.
- ▶ The Worship Leader is energetic.
- ▶ The Worship Leader works well with kid vocalists and/or dancers if they are on the schedule.

KEYS TO WINNING

BE COMMITTED TO PREPARATION TIME DURING THE WEEK.

- ▶ Pick up the series music CD and motions DVD.
- ▶ Spending a small amount of time memorizing and rehearsing the songs and motions over multiple days will be more effective than cramming the night before.
- ▶ Rehearse the script out loud several times to memorize all the written transitions. Sometimes the Worship Leader will be the only stage participant in KC Celebration (this happens when the teaching is on video) so it is important that he/she learns the Worship Leader lines.
- ▶ It is important that the Worship Leader understands the whole flow of the service since he/she is the primary person making transitions.

DURING WORSHIP

- ▶ Be able to teach the motions to the kids. You may be required to teach a new song.
- ▶ Smile and sing with energy and passion. Kids will follow your lead. If your having fun they will have fun.
- ▶ Ask for and respond to coaching from the Producer and Arts Coordinator.
- ▶ Greet kids as they arrive at KC Celebration. If possible, greet kids in the Welcome Areas before and after services. The more you engage with the kids the more they will feel connected to you.

CONNECT

- ▶ How are you experiencing Biblical community in your small group?
- ▶ How are you being cared for? What needs can be met?
- ▶ What have you been learning through Leadership Community?

CONTRIBUTE

- ▶ Are you tithing? What steps do you need to take in the area of generosity?
- ▶ Which spiritual gifts are you enjoying using the most? What is an area you would like to explore?
