



# KIDS' CITY SECURITY

Kids' City Security contributors help families raise growing 3C-Christ Followers by providing a loving environment where kids feel safe and parents feel confident.

## TIME COMMITMENT

- ▶ Weekly contribution in one Kids' City service time. Arrive at the time designated by the Service Coordinator and stay until all families have exited the Kids' City area.
- ▶ Invited to participate in Kids' City University.

## QUALIFICATIONS

- ▶ Security contributors must love people and have a firm but caring personality.
- ▶ Security contributors are moving towards maturity in the 3C's: Celebrate, Connect, Contribute.
- ▶ Security contributors must be able to work independently and think quickly.
- ▶ Security leaders must have a completed application, background check, 2 reference forms, and signed Kids' City Leader Covenant on file.

- ▶ Kids and families feel welcomed and safe in Kids' City areas.
- ▶ Leaders feel safe and supported.
- ▶ Parents feel confident with safety in Kids' City.

## KEYS TO WINNING

### HELP SHAPE A POSITIVE FIRST IMPRESSION OF GOD AND THE CHURCH IN KIDS AND FAMILIES AND BUILD CONFIDENCE WITH PARENTS.

- ▶ Learn as many kids' names and their parents' names as possible.
- ▶ Quickly identify new or visiting families, guide them to the welcome area, and make them feel safe and welcomed.
- ▶ Be a very visible presence throughout the service. Check on each small group room during the service time.
- ▶ Approach unauthorized people in Kids' City area. Kindly ask them to exit the Kids' City area.
- ▶ Record accurate attendance numbers.
- ▶ Provide back-up for the Welcome area.
- ▶ Connect families with the Service Coordinator or Campus Director if needed.
- ▶ Pray for the kids and families in Kids' City.

### SUPPORT LEADERS DURING SERVICE.

- ▶ Help leaders with discipline problems.
- ▶ Help leaders by escorting kids to bathrooms.
- ▶ Page parents for leaders as needed.
- ▶ Take charge helping leaders and children leave the building in case of emergency.

### OTHER

- ▶ Ensure the safety of kids by finding a substitute on weeks you need to be absent.
- ▶ Invite others to contribute with you in security.
